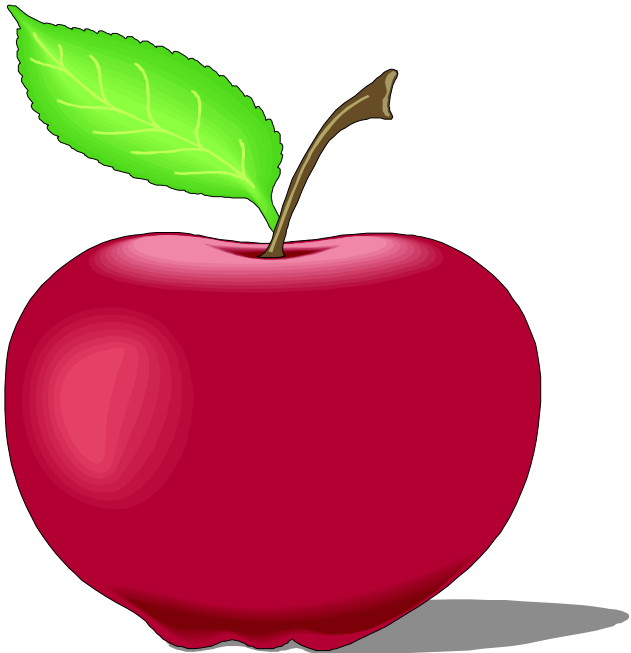


In vector graphics, drawings are created using geometric figures called "primitives" described by mathematical equations. The edges of the drawings are smoothed out and are not distorted during transformation, e.g. when resizing due to mathematical calculation of parameters.
